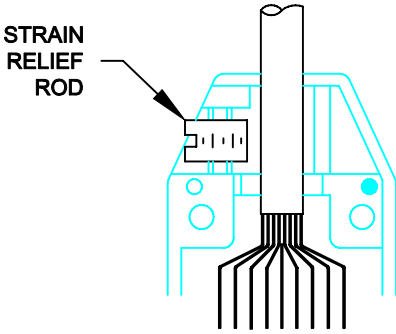
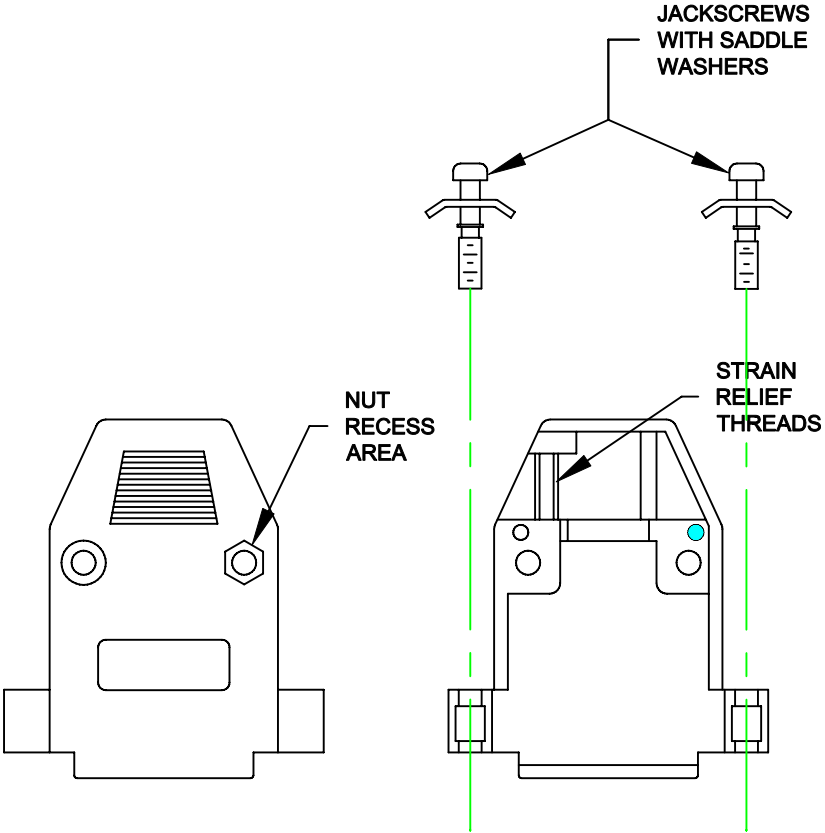
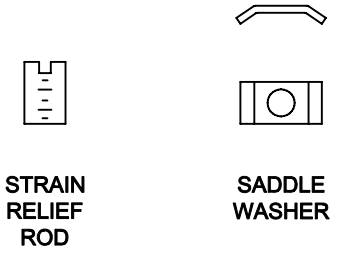


ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS:

1. PREPARE CABLE ENDS, CONNECT TO CONNECTOR
2. INSERT CABLE INTO ONE HALF OF HOOD
3. INSERT THE JACKSCREWS IN THE SADDLE WASHERS. PLACE THE JACKSCREWS INTO THE HOOD WITH THE CABLE
4. PLACE THE OTHER HALF OF THE HOOD ON TOP OF THE FIRST HALF, MAKING SURE NO WIRES ARE PINCHED
5. HOLDING THE HOOD HALVES TOGETHER, INSERT THE MOUNTING SCREWS THROUGH THE HOODS IN OPPOSITE DIRECTIONS. TIGHTEN THE TWO HALVES TOGETHER
6. INSERT STRAIN RELIEF ROD INTO THREADED HOLE. TIGHTEN SNUG BUT NOT TIGHT ENOUGH TO CUT THE WIRE OR JACKET

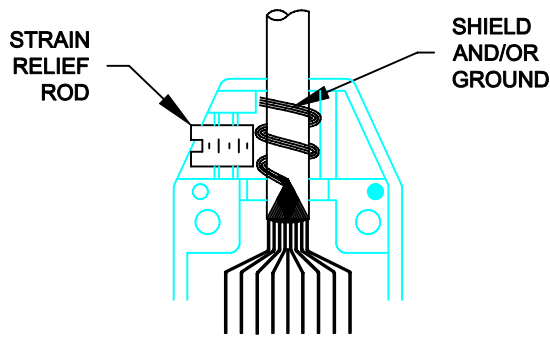
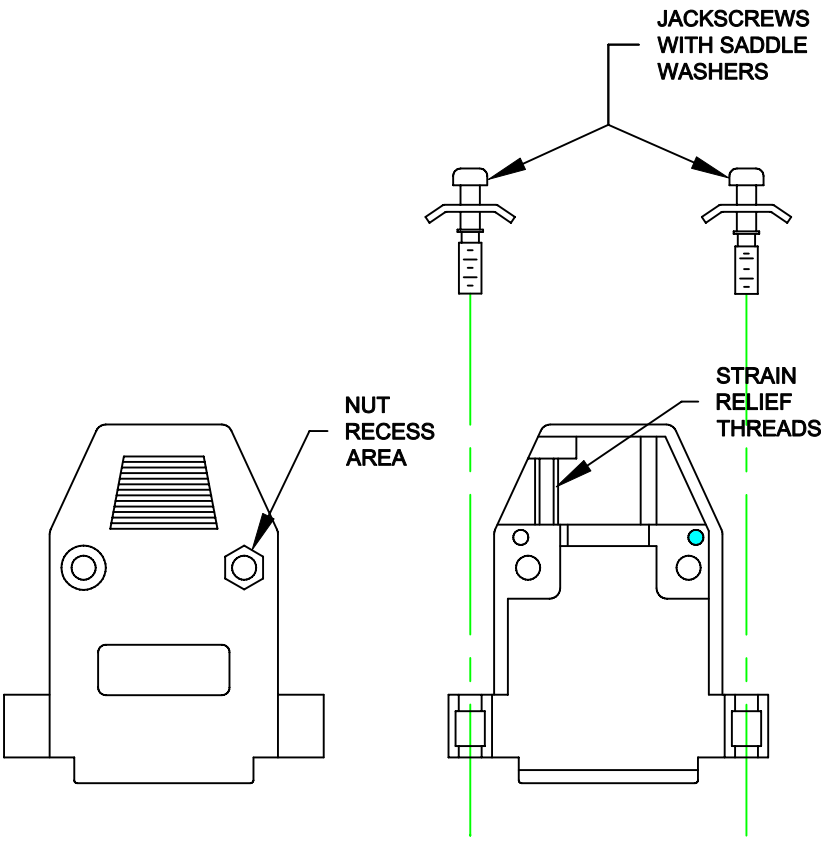

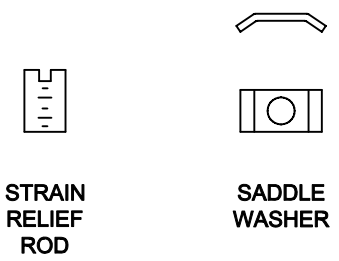

4. PLACE THE OTHER HALF OF THE HOOD ON TOP OF THE FIRST HALF, MAKING SURE NO WIRES ARE PINCHED
5. HOLDING THE HOOD HALVES TOGETHER, INSERT THE MOUNTING SCREWS THROUGH THE HOODS IN OPPOSITE DIRECTIONS. TIGHTEN THE TWO HALVES TOGETHER
